MAIL VOTING

If you will be away during the election you can apply to the city to vote by mail. Mail ballots can also be dropped in the City Hall mail box until **8 p.m. October 17.**



WHO CAN VOTE:

In order to vote, you must:

- ☒ Be 18 years of age or older on October 17, 2026
- ☒ Be a Canadian citizen
- ☒ Have lived in BC for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration
- ☒ Live in New Westminster, or own property registered in your name in New Westminster for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration
- ☒ Not be disqualified by law from voting

Renters can vote!



**All ballots must be cast by no later than
8 p.m. October 17.**

MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT!

Only 1 in 4 eligible residents voted in the last election. This is your opportunity to participate in local democracy and help choose the mayor, councillors, and school trustees who will shape the future of our community.
